Please enjoy our award winning gardens, having been judged in the "East Midlands in Bloom" competition as a gold winner every year continuously since 2014.


Swimming facilities unfortunately are no longer available.

Directions to Ringwood Hall Hotel & Spa

From M1 North (Junction 30): Follow signs for A619. Turn right onto A619 towards Staveley. Continue on this road, passing through Mastin Moor and Staveley. Continue on the A619, rising out of the valley Ringwood Hall & Spa is set back on the left hand side of this road.

From M1 South (Junction 29): Follow signs for A619. Travel along A617 until first roundabout; take third exit onto the A61. At the next roundabout (Tesco's) take the third exit signposted A619 Worksop. At the next roundabout (Sainsburys) take second exit, follow road uphill passing crematorium on right hand side. Bear left on the one way system, the hotel is situated on the right hand side as you descend down the hill.

From A61: Travelling out of Chesterfield town centre on the A61, join the A619 at the roundabout and continue on this road through Brimington, heading towards Staveley. We are a short distance down the road set back on the right.
